**Family Devotions** 

Hopefully your preteen is beginning to develop a habit of personal devotions. But there are still plenty of times when your input is needed—and valued. Encourage your child to read the daily Scriptures. Read the verses yourself. Use the questions to help your preteen understand the verses and apply them to life. Discover and learn from God's Word—together!

- O SUNDAY—Read 2 Kings 22:1-10.
  Josiah obeyed God. As king, Josiah gave instructions for the temple to be repaired. That's when the Book of the Law was found! Where do you keep God's Word?
- O MONDAY—Read 2 Kings 22:11-13.
  King Josiah tore his robes because he knew the people were not obeying God. Have you ever read something in the Bible that let you know you had done something wrong? What did you do about it?
- TUESDAY—Read 2 Kings 23:1-3. Josiah and the people committed themselves to follow God and keep His commands. What kind of commitment have you made to God?
- O WEDNESDAY—Read 2 Timothy 3:14-17.

  Do you remember who first taught you from the Bible? What should be the result when you study God's Word?
- THURSDAY—Read 2 Peter 1:19-21.
  God's Word is described as a light shining in a dark place. How can God's Word help light up the dark times in your life?

- O FRIDAY—Read Hebrews 4:12, 13.
  God's Word is described as being sharper than
  a double-edged sword. How do you feel when you
  remember that God knows everything about you?
- O **SATURDAY**—Read James 1:22-25.

  We aren't fooling anyone if we read the Bible but don't do what it says. What might be the result when we read and do what is written in the Bible?
