Family Devotions

Hopefully your preteen is beginning to develop a habit of personal devotions. But there are still plenty of times when your input is needed—and valued. Encourage your child to read the daily Scriptures. Read the verses yourself. Use the questions to help your preteen understand the verses and apply them to life. Discover and learn from God's Word—together!

- **SUNDAY**—Read Galatians 4:4-6.
God sent His Son “when the time had fully come.” How does it make you feel to know that God sent Jesus for you and God’s Spirit is now available to help you?
- **MONDAY**—Read Acts 13:26-33a.
Read verses 32 and 33a again. How does it help you to know that God always keeps His promises, even when things look bad?
- **TUESDAY**—Read Romans 3:22-24.
To whom does God want to give His gift of righteousness? What difference does it make in your life when you think about God sending His Son to forgive your sins?
- **WEDNESDAY**—Read 1 Timothy 2:5-7.
Paul says that he was appointed to be a “herald,” or messenger, for God. When can you be a “teacher of the true faith” like Paul?
- **THURSDAY**—Read 2 Peter 3:8, 9.
What does this text tell about God and time? How willing is God to wait for people to turn to Him?
- **FRIDAY**—Read John 3:16-18.
What motivated God to give His Son? What does God do for the person who believes in His Son? What is the result of not believing in Jesus?
- **SATURDAY**—Read Hebrews 9:27, 28.
What can we do to be ready for Jesus’ return?
