Family Devos (A Guide for Family Devotions)

Gather in a family room or around the kitchen table. Open a Bible. Read the verses listed. Answer the questions; respond to the statements. Listen to and share with one another. Grow in God's Word—together!

Set a goal for your family. Will you have devotions together one or two days a week? Can you work up to seven days?

- **SUNDAY**—Read James 5:17, 18.
An earnest prayer is a prayer that is seriously and strongly meant. What happened when Elijah prayed earnestly?
- **MONDAY**—Read James 5:16.
How would you describe the prayer of a righteous person?
- **TUESDAY**—Read Acts 12:5, 7, 11, 12.
For what kind of situations does our church congregation pray?
- **WEDNESDAY**—Read Daniel 6:10, 11.
How often should we talk to God? Are we willing to let others hear or see us pray?
- **THURSDAY**—Read Philemon 4-7.
For whom can we pray Paul's prayer found in these verses?
- **FRIDAY**—Read 1 Chronicles 5:20.
For what things can we trust God?
- **SATURDAY**—Read 1 Peter 4:1, 7.
How should we live so that we can pray?
